The Seneca Nation of Indians are made up of Expatriated Indians (R.S. 1499) and do not hold any land titles on the Ancient Confederacy of the Iroquois Territories (Cattaraugus and Alleghany), (Wallace 5, 74 U.S. 1857) in which the state had to surrender land to the Iroquois Confederacy because the land had never been ceded. Iroquois Confederacy territories are neither Indian Country nor an Indian Reservation but exclusive Confederacy territories. Any Members that are on enrollment and A.I.M. members or members of the Seneca Nation of Indians or other Corporate Bodies (389 F.S. U.P.P. 235 1975, United States vs. Consolidated Wounded Knee Cases) are not Signatory Indians or not members of Ancient Confederacy of the Iroquois and do not hold Sesin title to the territories because they are Expatriated Indians and the most they can hold is the right of occupancy, granted by the good graces of the Confederacy only.
